It's a win! You might have already heard the good news, but we're thrilled to share that **City Council voted 5-2 in favor of keeping Main Street car-free and pedestrian-friendly**. This means that Main Street can remain indefinitely closed under Vehicle Code 21101 while the city moves forward with the process outlined by the Pedestrian Mall Law.

We want to thank everyone who gave a public comment, sent in an email, sported a sticker, or spread the word. **This huge win is the result of your enthusiasm and support.** We also want to thank everyone who showed up to our pizza party. Watching friendly faces—familiar and new—bond over slices of pizza, homemade “brookies,” and a shared love for our city was a testament to the wonderful moments our special downtown has made possible.

Next up. City Council has an opportunity to direct \$500,000 of leftover Fiscal Year 2022 investment plan funding toward the long-term changes we've been asking for.
